G.S.R. 14.-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 64 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (Central Act No. 6 of 1974), the State Government after consultation with the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1975, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) (Amendment) Rules, 2007.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Amendment of rule 29.— In rule 29 of the Rajasthan Water Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules 1975, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, the existing sub rule (2) shall be substituted by the following, namely:-
 - "(2) Such application shall be accompanied by the fees as prescribed in Schedule IV:

Provided that where a person who is establishing or carrying on any industry, operation or process and is generating hazardous waste as defined under the Hazardous Wastes (Management & Handling) Rules, 1989; and requiring authorization thereunder;

the application for consent shall be accompanied with a fee equal to one and half times of the amount of fee prescribed under Schedule IV.

3. Amendment of Schedule IV.- The existing Schedule-IV appended to the said rules shall be substituted by the following, namely:-
