Background:

In order to assess the impact of predominating Noise Level in Jaipur city, Noise Level Monitoring was conducted at 6 different locations in Jaipur City from July to September, 2018.

The Noise level monitoring was conducted day time (1100 hrs to 2200 hrs) and night time (2200 hrs onwards) for half hour interval at each location with sampling frequency of one second.

Monitoring Locations:

In order to maintain uniformity in monitoring, Residential, Commercial, and Silence zones were selected in respect of Noise Standards prescribed under the provisions of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000. The monitoring network consisted of a total of 6 noise monitoring locations in Jaipur City.





Fig. 2 Noise Level during Night time from July to September in Jaipur City





Conclusion:

During the monitoring period, the concentration of Leq dB(A) has exceeded the prescribed standards both during day and night time.

On comparison of data between day and night time, it has been observed that the noise level has decreased at all monitoring locations from day to night time except at Nagar Nigam Office, Patel Marg, Mansarovar in September, 2018.

It has also been observed that an increasing trend in data during the entire monitoring period i.e. from July to September, 2018 has been observed at Garden Behind Governor House, Civil Lines (day time), SDMH near OPD (day time),

Science Park, Shastri Nagar (day time) and Gali No. 3, Raja Park (both day and night time).
