Office-Order

Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the matter of Original Application No.34/2014(THC) Digvijay Singh v/s State of Rajasthan & Others by order dated 06.03.2019 directed that the concerned department of State Government shall implement the action plan suggested by the committee in its report dated 19.02.2019 (from pg. 50 to pg. 59). The relevant points are as under:-

1. The installation of 18.0 MLD capacity RO Plant has to be speed up. It should be installed within next 3 months. If it is not, CETP Balotra should pay compensation against damage to environment and ecosystems.

No further new industries, particularly generate trade effluents should be allowed by RSPCB till existing industries meet the prescribed effluent standards.

In compliance of Hon'ble NGT direction, the State Board issued an office order vide letter no. F14(Gen-3)/Tech/RSPCB/Plg/21-CETP/35-45 dated 02.04.2019 that no Consent to Establish will be issued to any new industry or CTE for expansion of any existing industrial units which generate trade effluent, till existing industries meet the prescribed effluent standards in the Balotra, Bithuja and Jasol.

In the mean time, the CETP trust at Balotra has installed facility to treat and maintain ZLD status for trade effluent upto 18 MLD & Consent to Operate has also been issued to the CETP to treat trade effluent upto 18 MLD vide order no. 2022-2023/Liquid Waste/1295 dated 12.05.2022, which is valid till 31.07.2026.

Thereafter, the matter has been re-examined and the State Board office order dated 02.04.2019 is partially modified to the extent that Balotra is deleted from coverage of order dated 02.04.2019.

In view of above, the establishment of new units and expansion of existing units connected to the CETP for treatment of trade effluent in Balotra is permitted subject to following conditions:-

- (a) That the total trade effluent by member units discharging to CETP shall not exceed 18 MLD.
- (b) CETP, Balotra Trust shall submit a list of industries with allotted trade effluent duly approved by the District Monitoring Committee to the State Board.
- (c) Units shall apply for Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate as the case may be with a valid certificate of allowed trade effluent by CETP Trust.

This bears approval of the competent authority.
